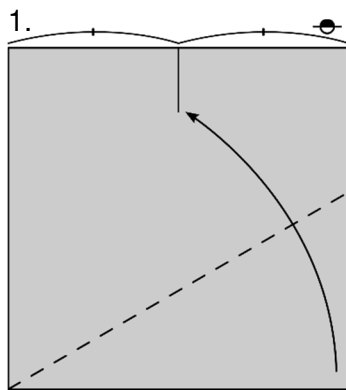

Difficulty level: Simple, 9 modules.

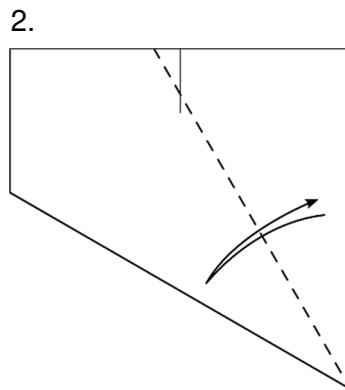
Diameter 12 cm out of 5 cm squares.

Recommended paper: copy paper (80 g/m²)
works fine.

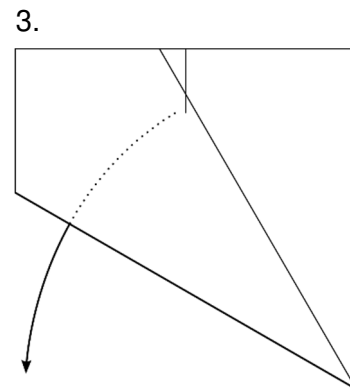
Module



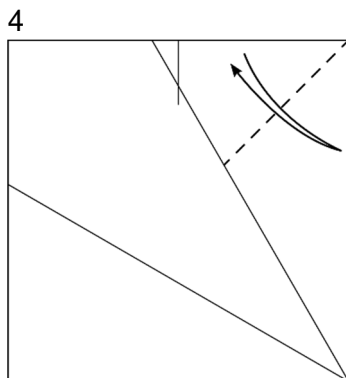
1. Fold a short line at the midpoint of the top edge and fold the bottom right corner of the paper to the line with folding line meeting the lower left corner (the right angle is divided into 60° and 30°).



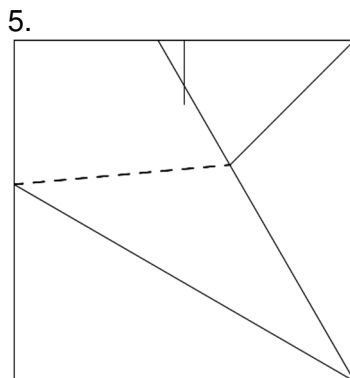
2. Turn the paper over. Fold the bisector of the 60° angle and unfold.



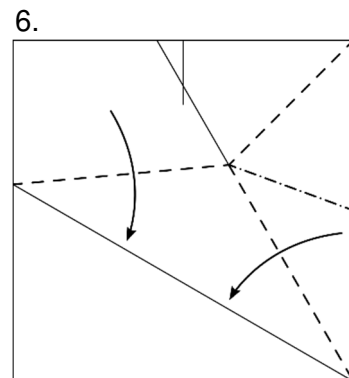
3. Unfold the first fold (the triangle behind).



4. Fold the bisector of the right angle. Fold to the first line only. Unfold.

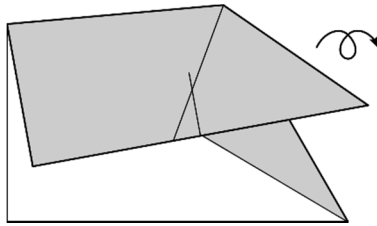


5. Fold between points.



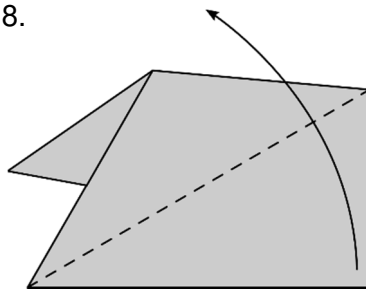
6. Fold a rabbit ear along the existing lines and collapse the module. A new line appears.

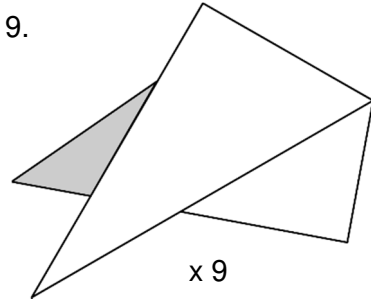
The closed module.

Fold along the existing line.

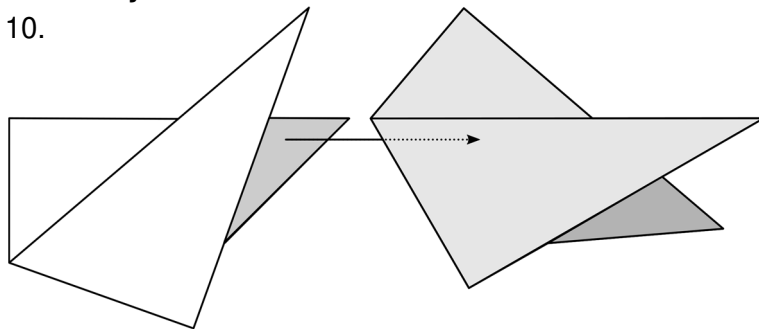

The module is ready.

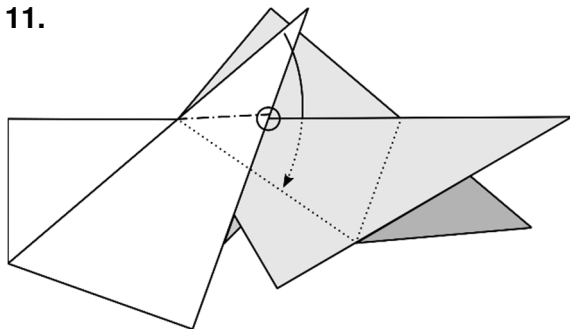
Assembly

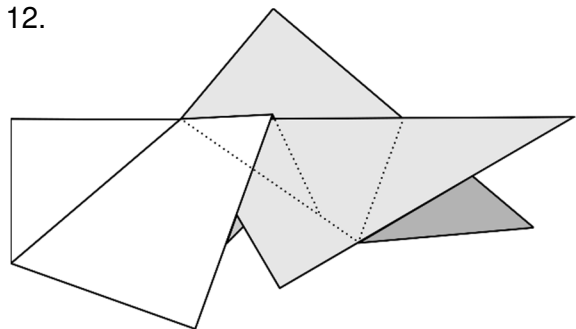
Slide-in as far as possible.
